

DISTRIBUTION OF LITERATURE

The Board of Education shall permit the distribution of literature from school based and external not-for-profit organizations except, in the opinion of the Superintendent of Schools or designee, that such literature clearly represents political, commercial, or profit-making activities.

The time for distribution shall not interfere with regular class time. Distribution may occur following school hours or before/after school activities. Any student has the right to accept or reject the literature being distributed.

The district reserves the right to deny distribution of literature if it will cause a disruption in the education process.

Guidelines will be defined in the accompanying regulations to this policy.
