

RELATIONS WITH COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

The Board of Education recognizes that harmonious relations with various community organizations are essential to the smooth operation of the schools. The Board and district staff will encourage and work with those organizations whose purpose is to improve educational and extracurricular opportunities in the schools of the district and will cooperate whenever possible with other groups when they express a particular interest in activities or programs in the district.

Volunteers

The Board of Education designates the month of May as "Honor Volunteer Month" in the community in recognition of those who volunteer their services and add their expertise and assistance to the educational program, thereby enhancing the educational opportunities of the district's students.

Gold Card Program

In recognition of the many years of devoted service and support by the senior citizens in the district, the Board has established the Gold Card Club for individuals aged 60 or older.

Gold Card Club members are eligible for free admission to all school-sponsored activities to which the public is generally invited, such as athletic events, music, dramatic presentations.
